- 2. Employee's, Retired Employee's, or Legal Spouse's unmarried children by birth, legal adoption, or legal (courtappointed) guardianship that are the age of twenty-three (23) or younger on January 1st.
- 3. Employee's or Retired Employee's unmarried children by birth, legal adoption, or legal (court-appointed) guardianship of any age and who are incapable of self-support because of mental or physical disability.
- 4. Disabled Dependents are unable to engage in substantial gainful employment to the degree they can achieve economic independence due to medically determinable physical or mental impairment which can be expected to last for a continuous period of time, are chiefly dependent upon the Employee, Retired Employee, unmarried widow, or widower for support and maintenance since they reached age 24.
- 5. Parents of the current or Retired Employees who qualify as the Employee's dependent for federal income tax purposes.
- 6. Employee's or Retired Employee's foster child provided the child is less than eighteen (18) years of age on January 1st.
- Children under six (6) years of age do not require a transit pass to use the transit system.
