RIDE UTA FREE

BYU students, faculty, staff, and their spouses and dependents can ride UTA buses, TRAX, FrontRunner and the Utah Valley Express (UVX) for free! The UTA transit pass is built directly into your BYU ID smartcard. Simply tap your student ID when boarding **and** exiting*. New students can obtain their BYU ID at the BYU ID Center, located at 1057 WSC.

Look for the bus rapid transit system, Utah Valley Express (UVX).

UVX is a line featuring articulated buses that will reduce travel times using exclusive bus lanes and transit signal priority. With buses coming every 6-10 minutes on weekdays**, UVX will connect FrontRunner with major Utah Valley destinations including universities, employment centers, entertainment, shopping malls and downtown Orem and Provo.

On and near campus, find UVX stops along University Parkway, 900 N., 700 N. and University Ave.

Sunday service to Salt Lake City and the airport.

Additionally, beginning August 11, UTA will have service to the SLC International Airport and Salt Lake City on Sunday, via a bus route 850 to 871 connection to TRAX. Please note, FrontRunner does not operate on Sunday.

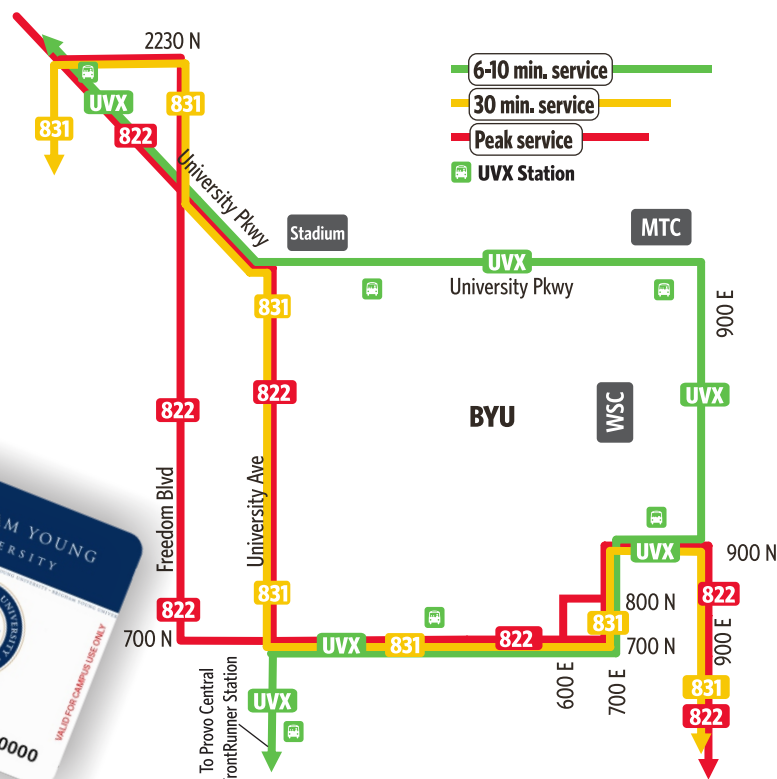
