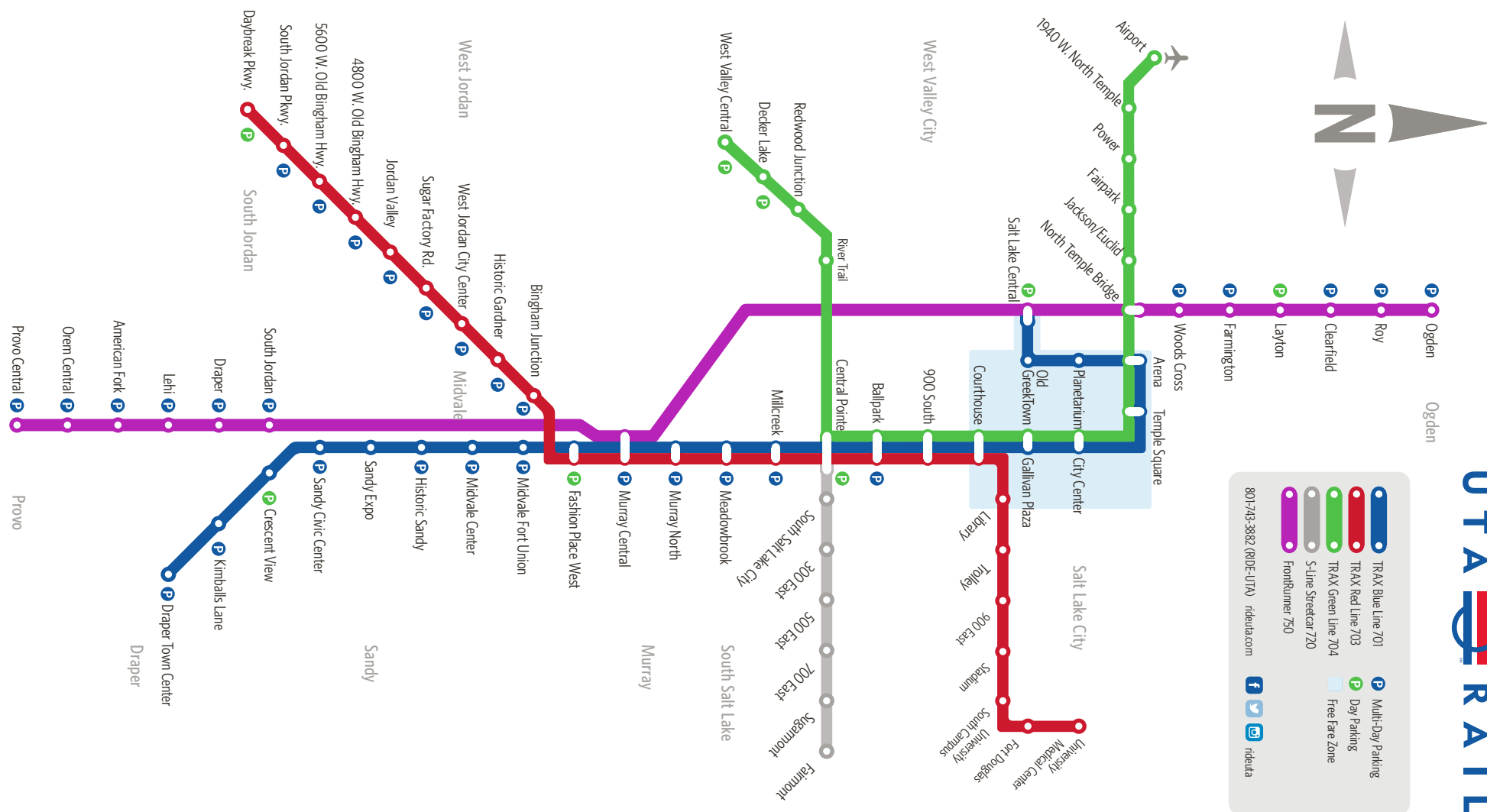


# Rail System Map

### FARES

Exact Fare is required. Fares are subject to change.

### TRANSFERS

Upon payment of a fare, a transfer is good for travel in any  
direction, including return trip, for two (2) hours until the  
time cut. The value of a transfer towards a fare on a more  
expensive service is the regular cash fare.

FrontRunner, TRAX and UTA bus fares cover your Streetcar  
fare as long as you transfer from FrontRunner, TRAX or UTA  
Bus within the time window shown on your FrontRunner ticket  
or Bus transfer. Streetcar fare counts towards the larger price  
of your TRAX fare.

### BICYCLES

On TRAX and Streetcar Bicycles must board through  
the front and rear doors only of each car in the train.  
No bicycles are allowed on the access ramp. On FrontRunner  
Bicycles can be stored in racks located on the main floor of  
cars showing a bicycle symbol.
